What is a Planned Gift?

A planned gift is any major gift made during your lifetime or at death as part of a donor's overall financial and/or estate planning.

Give Wisely

You are concerned for your own financial needs and those of your family, but you believe deeply in the mission of **Community Caregivers of Greater Derry** and want to be a force for good in the lives of vulnerable community members for years to come. The estate of a person without a will is divided up according to state law. By drawing up a will you can protect your loved ones, distribute your property according to your wishes, and include gifts to your favorite charities.

Gifts-at-a-Glance

Give Now . . .

CASH To make an outright gift of cash, simply make out your check to **Community Caregivers of Greater Derry** and note that your donation is a planned gift.

STOCKS To make an outright gift of stock, please have your broker contact our office for delivery instructions. Deduct the full market value from your taxes and avoid the capital gains tax.

Outright gifts made during your lifetime are tax deductible to the extent allowable by law.

Give Later . . .

BEQUESTS After your death, you can make a gift to **Community Caregivers of Greater Derry** through your will. You may designate a fixed amount, a percentage of your estate or the residual after all other bequests have been made.

LIFE INSURANCE or IRA Likewise, you can make a distribution from your life insurance policy or Individual Retirement Account by naming us as a beneficiary on your policy or account.

Gifts by Bequest or Life Insurance or IRA are exempt from estate taxes.
