Used durable medical equipment for loan is available at no charge for as long as needed. Individuals and/or service providers can have arrangements made to pick up the item(s) needed by calling the office for availability. Clean and gently used equipment gladly accepted. A tax deduction letter is provided upon request if items were purchased out of pocket.

Common items donated and requested

(in alphabetical order):

Bath seats, bed assist rails, blood pressure kits, canes, commodes, crutches, gait belts, grabbers, knee scooters, manual wheelchairs, raised toilet seats, rollators, sock aids, transfer benches, transport wheelchairs, versa frames, walkers and bariatric equipment of all types.

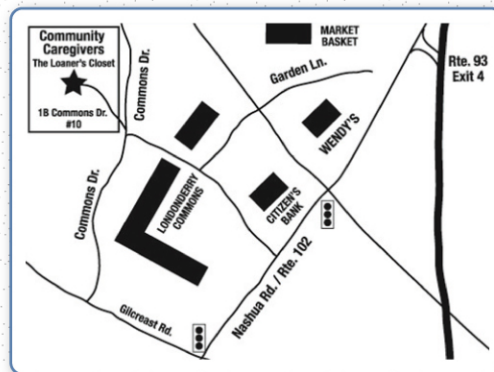
Consumable items such as:

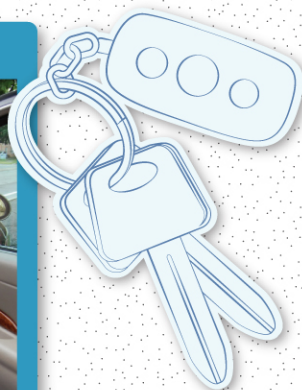

Regular shopping trips either with or for an individual.

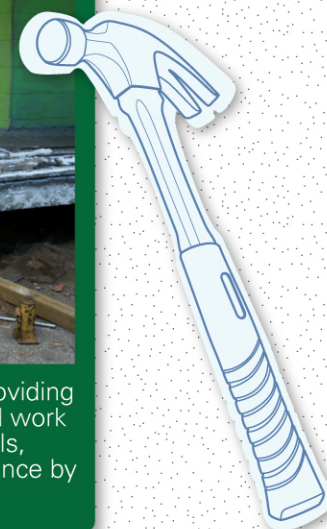
CHORES
